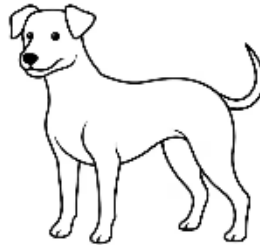

Dear Broadus Family;

The Proverbs of Solomon says “the person that being often reproved hardeneth their neck, shall suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy”.

The question for us in August is not “if” we need to be reproved, corrected, disciplined, chastised, or called down but it's can we take it if we are corrected/reproved/rebuked by His Word? If you cannot, you will never go any further with the Lord. Why? You cannot take it and will harden (make stiff) your neck. When your neck is stiff or you've ever had a “crick in your neck”, you cannot turn (repent). If I cannot take correction from the Word, then there is a consequence coming for me. I or you, will SUDDENLY be destroyed. None want that. So, I need to learn to take correction on matters in the Bible as I grow in grace and knowledge of His Word. If I do not, the last of the verse says “there is no remedy”. No help. No intervention. No person can come to your aid.
